



















Do you know the new guidance on self-isolation?

IF YOU'RE FULLY VACCINATED OR UNDER 18: YOU NO LONGER NEED TO SELF-ISOLATE IF YOU'RE A CLOSE CONTACT OF SOMEONE WHO TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

14 DAYS MUST HAVE PASSED SINCE YOUR SECOND DOSE



But you still need to get a PCR test as soon as possible to check whether you have the virus.

You don't need to isolate whilst waiting for the results, but it might be a good idea to take extra precautions. People who are double vaccinated can still get COVID-19, so wear a mask in public places, limit contact with others and consider those who are more vulnerable
