## A meeting of this Council was held in the Pavilion, Caldecote On Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2023.

- 1. Public open forum. There were no public comments.
- 2. District Councillors Report. Cllr. Tumi Hawkins (SCDC). Members welcomed Cllr. Hawkins, her report will be published in due course.
- 3. Apologies for absence. Cllrs. Nair and Pritchard
- **4. Members' declarations of pecuniary or non-pecuniary interests.** There were none.
- **5. Chairman's Announcements –** There were none.
- **6. Minutes of the last Meeting** The minutes of the Council meeting 5<sup>th</sup> January 2023 were approved as a correct record and duly signed by Cllr Polly Field, (Chairman).
- 7. Actions and updates:
  - Speed monitoring: The Clerk reported that he had received no response for the need for volunteers to monitor the speed signs. Members agreed to revisit the subject at the next meeting.
  - Warm Hub: The Vice-Chairman (Councillor Mrs Cartwright) reported that the warm hub was still attracting members of the public on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

- S/1524/16/CONDD: Submission of details required by condition 8 (Foul water drainage). At, Land west of Casa D Foseta, St Neots Road, Caldecote.

- **20/0553/CONDB:** Submission of details required by condition 4 (Hard and soft landscaping). At, 121, Highfields Road, Caldecote. **No Objection**.
- 21/03681/FUL: Demolition of existing dwelling and buildings and erection of 3 dwellings. At, 42 West Drive, Highfields, Caldecote. No Objection.
- **22/00509/CONDA**: Submission of details required by condition 4 (Boundary treatments) and 8 (Materials Drive). At, Southwind, Highfields Road, Highfields, Caldecote. **Object, the VDS states "no fencing, hedging only".**

 23/00002/HFUL: Construct new double garage and workshop with 1<sup>st</sup> floor office/wc/storage. At, 95A Highfields Road, Highfields, Caldecote. No Objection

- 9. Financial Reports -
  - Summary of receipts and payments. Was received.
  - **Bank Reconciliation**. The bank reconciliation dated 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023 was received and approved.
  - Accounts for payment. The schedule of payments was received. It was RESOLVED that the RFO be authorised to make payment of all the accounts.
- **10. Capital Expenditure and the way forward.** At the meeting of 5<sup>th</sup> January 2023 members agreed that the priorities for capital spending would be as follows:
  - Fencing between the playpark and access road
  - Surfacing of the carpark and access road
  - Replacement bollards to stop un-authorised parking on grass verges.
  - New outside toilets
  - Alterations to pavilion to increase useable space.

The Clerk reported that he had sought tenders for the fencing between the car park and playing field, including the replacement bollards. The tender recommended by the Chairman and Vice-Chairman was for the sum of £28,054 + VAT. Members endorsed the recommendation.

The Clerk reported that he had a meeting with a representative of Portakabin Ltd, regarding the replacement outside toilet block. A scheme would be available shortly.

The Clerk also reported that he had received tenders for a storage container.

The Clerk reported that he was seeking tenders for the work to the Pavilion.

Members approved the Clerk to engage a Structural Engineer to design the new layout to the Pavilion.

- **13. Councillors questions.** Councillor Barker commented about the state of the road gullies.
